

AEEDC Dubai 2025: Kuwait Named Guest of Honour of the 29th Edition

Dubai, United Arab Emirates, January 27, 2025: The 29th edition of the **UAE International Dental Conference and Arab Dental Exhibition—AEEDC Dubai 2025**, is set to kick off next week in Dubai.
