COP5: Invitation to Support FDI's **Response on Dental Smalgam**



The 5th meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Minamata Convention on Mercury (COP5), which includes provisions for the phase down of the use of dental amalgam (Annex A, Part II) will take place from 30 October to 3 November in Geneva, Switzerland.

Ahead of COP5 a proposal to amend Part I and Part II of Annex A has been and Burkina Faso.

- For Annex A: Part dental amalgam is proposed for inclusion with a 2030 phase-out date.
- For Annex A: Part II, two additional provisions are proposed for inclusion.





Promoting Oral Health in Schools: A Joint Initiative by Baqai Dental College and Colgate



The Department of Community Dentistry at Baqai Dental College partnered with Colgate for a community outreach activity. The week-long program was held from September 18th to 22nd, 2023. A dedicated team of faculty members from the Department of Community Dentistry, led by the Head of Department, actively participated in the oral screening program along with few House officers aiming to enhance awareness about oral health and nurture the habit of maintaining oral hygiene among school children.

Operative Workshop at Sir Syed

Dr. Zareen demonstrated the procedure live for students and faculty. She stressed the importance of proper isolation during root canal treatment to improve the success rate of the procedure.

Dr. Hasan Askari, HOD dental materials, also stressed the implementation of the rubber dam during the junior operative workshop. He further elaborated a sterile and dry treatment area to prevent bacteria from entering the canals.

The SS Admin greatly lauded the efforts of the senior dental faculty to promote dental education amongst students and faculty.

Baqai Dental College Workshop: Fluoride Varnish Application



Fluoride varnish application, which are typically administered by professional dentists or hygienists due to their high fluoride concentration, are commonly used to prevent dental decay. Consequently, the Department of Community Dentistry at Baqai Dental College accented the importance of this procedure through a workshop conducted on 28th September 2023.

The session was spearheaded by Prof. Dr. Asghar Ali Shigri. He engaged the 2nd year BDS students with an informative discourse on the significance of fluoride varnish, guidelines for application, its advantages, and the procedure for administering professional fluoride varnish. He stressed the fact that although topical fluoride application is beneficial, it holds special importance for those falling in moderate to high-risk categories. Moreover, its role in tooth decay prevention is crucial because it is absorbed into the tooth enamel, strengthening it, and

making it resistant to acid attack by oral bacteria, thereby, reducing the risk of tooth decay.

Following the lecture, a hands-on session was provided for the students in a phantom head setting. The application procedure was demonstrated for improved comprehension. Subsequently, students were allowed to practically perform the demonstrated steps independently but under the professional supervision of Dr. Samreen Mazhar, Dr. Mehwish Bano, and Dr. Wajiha Anzar.





BDC's Workshop on High Fluoride Gel Use for Preventing Dental Caries in High-Risk Populations

High Fluoride gel treatments are professional procedures that use a potent concentration of fluoride, which dentists or dental hygienists administer.

The use of fluoride gels has become common as they serve as effective agents against dental caries. Recognizing the importance of these treatments and their proper application, the Department of Community Dentistry conducted a workshop. This event aimed to educate students of 2nd year BDS on the application and benefits of fluoride treatments held on 14th September 2023.

Prof. Dr. Asghar Ali Shigri inaugurated the session by delivering a comprehensive lecture to second-year BDS students. His lecture encompassed a range of topics including the significance of fluoride, various forms of professionally-applied fluoride, and

practices to follow when applying fluoride treatments. He also highlighted the benefits and possible side effects of fluoride use, along with the process of applying professional fluoride gel.

The emphasis was particularly placed on the effectiveness of topical fluoride application across different age demographics, especially in groups displaying moderate to high risk of dental issues.

The students were then directed to the phantom head lab where practical steps of application were showcased. This hands-on approach allowed students to individually carry out each step under the guidance of Assistant Profssors Dr. Samreen Mazhar, Dr. Mehwish Bano, Dr. Raza Abidi, and Dr. Wajiha Anzar.

WHO introduces new pilot scheme for Expert Review Panel for Diagnostic Products for neglected tropical diseases

assurance and accessibility of NTD diagnostic tools for health-care providers. The landscape of in-vitro diagnostics (IVDs) is rapidly evolving, posing significant challenges to procurers, health-care programmes, and authorities for public health and patient care. Notably, in the field of NTD diagnostics, challenges are multiple. Low profit margins and limited returns on investment make the NTD diagnostics market unattractive to manufacturers and suppliers resulting in uncertainty about the quality of many NTD diagnostic products. Additionally, the revision of regulatory frameworks all over the world and in western countries for IVDs, associated with expensive procedures, has disrupted the availability of some NTD diagnostics. While solutions are being proposed to manufacturers, regulatory bodies and health care programmes to make the best choices for procurement of quality-assured, safe and performant IVDs for the benefit of public health through WHOs IVD prequalification programme (WHO PQ), they are not appropriate for all categories of IVDs. Currently, NTD diagnostics do not fall within the scope of WHO prequalification. To address this issue, WHO PQ is introducing the ERPD pilot scheme for NTDs. This new ERPD is intended to fill the critical need for NTD diagnostic tools by providing independent expert advice on specific categories of IVDs. The ERPD is an independent advisory body of technical experts, coordinated by the WHO PQ team to assess the risks and benefits associated with non-prequalified IVDs, for specific intended use, within specific settings and that may have a significant public health impact, like NTD diagnostics. This programme represents a significant step towards ensuring that NTD diagnostics meet international quality standards, It will provide procurers, donors and national disease control programmes with advice to aid procurement decisions for candidate products. The proposed ERPD for NTDs will be coordinated by the WHO PQ team in close collaboration with the Global NTD Programme, reaffirming WHO's dedication to tackling NTDs and enhancing global health equity and patient care. 'Basic Principles of Implantology' Session at BUHS

He spoke on the topic "Basic Principles of





Implantology".It was attended by 3rd year BDS students and faculty from different departments of Bahria University Health Sciences Campus. Dr. Zaheer enlightened the audience on the 'Basics of Implantology'. He further shed light on the concept of different eras of implantsand phases of Implant evolution. He shared detailed clinical, theoretical and latest knowledge through research about dental implant techniques and showed a number of clinical cases related to implant surgery performed by him. His dynamic approach of the topic proved to be extremely beneficial, especially for the students attending the lecture.

Following the lecture, the students asked Dr Zaheer about their queries regarding dental implants, which he answered in detail. Dr Zaheer Hussain Chachar was highly appreciated by Prof. Dr Kashif Naqvi, Principal Bahria University Dental College, and other senior faculty members for an informative session. Hands-on 'Basic Life Support' Assessment at Bahria

"Take some time to learn first aid and CPR. It saves lives and it works"- Bobby Sherman A hands-on "Basic Life Support" assessment was organized by Periodontology Department in Collaboration with General Medicine at Bahria University Dental College on 13 September, 2023. The activity was led by Surgeon Commander (Surg Cdr®) Prof Dr. Pervaiz Asghar and Prof Dr. Farzeen Tanwir both of whom enlightened the importance of BLS Assessment for healthcare professionals and its essential role in their daily life. This activity aims to evaluate skills of house officers and final year's students in BLS technique since its part of the curriculum as well, ensuring they can counter effectively to life threatening emergencies. Basic Life Support Training is crucial because it train individuals how to properly manage critical medical emergencies, such as cardiac arrest and obstructed airways. Dr. Pervaiz Asghar conducted a comprehensive demonstration of BLS techniques using a mannequin as a teaching aid. Each participant had the opportunity to practice these techniques on the mannequin, allowing them to apply their knowledge in a hands-on setting. Following tools were used for the assessment such as Manikins for hands on practice, Automated External Defibrillator (AEDs) and bag valve mask (BVM) AmbuBag. Initial assessment, airway maintenance, rescue breathing, mouth-to-mouth ventilation, exhaled air ventilation, and chest compressions are the primary components of BLS training.

The skills and knowledge of the healthcare professionals were evaluated by Prof Dr Farzeen Tanwir, Dr. Tauquer Bibi and Dr. Bushra Ijaz. Hence BLS training teaches valuable life-saving skills and techniques that can be applied in professional and personal life.

- · The material used for files is workable and has fatigue resistance that prevents the accidental breakage of K flies during the treatment procedure.
- · The color-coded ends denote the specific diameter of each file according to canal shape.
- · The set of k flies are reusable after sterilization in an autoclave and can tolerate the high temperature of sterilization.
- · The additional benefits of files are the tactile sensation during filing that reduces the chances of procedural errors.
- · K flies can be used in the filing, reaming, or up and down motion in the root canal.



Key Work Steps Of MM Niti Files

- · The length is only 16mm and suitable for deciduous teeth preparation
- · The standardized taper with obturation by standard gutta percha point
- · Enable creation of a smooth glide path and determine the working length by hand used k
- Use MM file .03 taper #20, #25 and #30 to finish the preparation.
- Attention: the root canal wall of the deciduous teeth is very thin, no need to cut too much.
